Queensland Theatre Artistic Director, Lee Lewis has today welcomed Rod Ainsworth to the Company as Director of Programming.

“Rod has such vast experience as a creative producer and theatre maker, especially with his work in regional Queensland and we are excited to add his passion, expertise and leadership to our Programming team,” she said.

Rod joins Queensland Theatre from his current role as Manager of Arts & Cultural Services with Bundaberg Regional Council where he has managed the Moncrieff Entertainment Centre, two regional galleries, a First Nations Cultural Development program, community arts program and the Regional Arts Development Fund.

He was a co-founder of not-for-profit production company Creative Regions Limited, and chaired the steering committee that led to the establishment of the Regional Arts Services Network. Rod currently serves as Vice President of Stage Queensland.

Rod commences as Director of Programming from 6 April, replacing Sophia Hall who recently relocated to Darwin to take up the position of CEO at Brown’s Mart Theatre.
